

Bonding Request 2022

- True Friends is asking for \$10,000,000 million to build a new pool, two gyms, and a welcome center at Camp Courage. The project in total is \$20,000,000 million, True Friends is requesting 50% of the project cost.
- Phase I has been completed and funded by donors. In this phase, site plans and construction estimates have been determined. Environmental Phase I audit and site surveys are completed.
- Corrina Township has signed on to be our Public Entity (Fiscal Agent).



Bonding Preparation

- True Friends is using their land, therefore no land purchase is needed.
- Completed Capital Campaign Feasibility Study. Currently have identified up to \$4.14 million in philanthropy support.

The Need for Bonding Support

- The current pool, gym, and welcome center are over 50 years old and beyond repair.
- Existing systems such as water heaters and pool systems are outdated and inefficient.
- New pool will include modern splash pad features, zero-entry, and more.
- New gym will include 2 courts, stage for performing arts, and more.
