

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 4157 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, delete section 2 and insert:

1.3 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 256B.056, subdivision 7, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 7. **Period of eligibility; 12-month continuous eligibility.** (a) Eligibility is available
1.5 for the month of application and for three months prior to application if the person was
1.6 eligible in those prior months. A redetermination of eligibility must occur every 12 months.

1.7 (b) For a person eligible for an insurance affordability program as defined in section
1.8 256B.02, subdivision 19, who reports a change that makes the person eligible for medical
1.9 assistance, eligibility is available for the month the change was reported and for three months
1.10 prior to the month the change was reported, if the person was eligible in those prior months.

1.11 (c) Once determined eligible for medical assistance, the following individuals shall be
1.12 continuously eligible for up to 12 months:

1.13 (1) children under age 19;

1.14 (2) children ages 19 and 20;

1.15 (3) parents and relative caretakers, whose medical assistance eligibility is determined
1.16 using the modified adjusted gross income methodology under section 256B.056, subdivision
1.17 1a, paragraph (b);

1.18 (4) adults without children, whose medical assistance eligibility is determined using the
1.19 modified adjusted gross income methodology under section 256B.056, subdivision 1a,
1.20 paragraph (b); and

1.21 (5) adults who were in foster care at age 18, enrolled in medical assistance under section
1.22 256B.055, subdivision 17.

2.1 (d) Continuous eligibility for pregnant women shall be as provided under section
2.2 256B.055, subdivision 6, and continuous eligibility for certain infants under age one shall
2.3 be determined as provided under section 256B.057, subdivision 1, paragraph (c).

2.4 (e) The commissioner shall seek any necessary federal waivers and approvals to
2.5 implement continuous eligibility as provided in paragraph (c).

2.6 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2023, or upon federal approval,
2.7 whichever is later. The commissioner of human services shall notify the revisor of statutes
2.8 when federal approval is obtained."
