I am writing regarding the walk through for the Omnibus Bill in the House Education Policy Committee H.F. No. 1081 on the testing requirements for homeschool and the proposed language that would require homeschoolers to submit a copy of their official test scores to the superintendent. This would create an undue burden on both homeschoolers and would be contrary to the 2011 Homeschool Mandate Reduction bill. The would also create more work for school districts and at the time of this mandate, they did not want to receive and maintain unnecessary paperwork from homeschoolers. Additionally, I do not see the reason for the state to require that I submit private data about my children to the school district, which I view as unconstitutional.
