

Current ABRT Scope


- Focused on the station area with accessibility upgrades in two intersection quadrants.


When we can, local agencies step up to ensure ABRT success






Lake Street corridor – current configuration


City and county invested tens of millions along Lake Street to improve safety, accessibility and provide transit advantages with the B Line project.
