Re: HF 2051 (Morrison, City of Minnetonka Beach)

Originally constructed in 1958, most of the components of our City water treatment plant have exceeded their life expectancy. A recent MN Department of Health inspection reported 10 pages of plant deficiencies, many of them safety related. The photos in your meeting packet of the interior and exterior of the plant provide compelling evidence of our City's urgent need to build a new water treatment plant. To build and fund this plant, Minnetonka Beach is a small community of only 230 household taxpayers.

In the past nine years, these 230 households have funded:

- A 2020 \$1.2M bond for a replacement water tower after safety inspections showed interior/exterior (tank) corrosion;
- A 2019 \$2.5M bond for watermain replacement;
- A 2012 \$1.4M bond for watermain replacement.

TOTAL: \$5.1M

In the next 10 years, Minnetonka Beach must plan to bond for:

- \$20.8M to replace 4 miles of street and storm sewer;
- \$4.4M to replace the remaining 85-year-old watermains that have exceeded their life span.

TOTAL: \$25.2M

In conclusion, Minnetonka Beach is a small city of 230 households. We desperately need your help to fund a new water treatment plant that will ensure the health and safety of our water supply.



1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. MINNETONKA BEACH; WATER TREATMENT PLANT
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7	to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Minnetonka Beach for site
1.8	preparation, including demolition of the existing water treatment plant, and to predesign,
1.9	design, engineer, construct, and equip a new water treatment plant. This appropriation is
1.10	available after the commissioner of management and budget determines that an amount
1.11	sufficient to complete the project has been committed to the project, as required by Minnesota
1.12	Statutes, section 16A.502. Amounts spent by the city of Minnetonka Beach to replace water
1.13	mains and a water tower count toward the local match for this project.
1.14	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.15	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.16	the state in an amount up to \$4,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.17	prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.18	Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
1.19	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.


