1.22 acts committed with sexual or aggressive intent:

1.23 (i) the intentional touching by the actor of the complainant's intimate parts;

2.1 (ii) the touching by the complainant of the actor's, the complainant's, or another's intimate  
2.2 parts;

2.3 (iii) the touching by another of the complainant's intimate parts;

2.4 (iv) in any of the cases listed above, touching of the clothing covering the immediate

2.11 of the actor's or another's bare genitals or anal opening with sexual or aggressive intent.

2.13 Subd. 12. **Sexual penetration.** "Sexual penetration" means any of the following acts  
2.14 committed without the complainant's consent, except in those cases where consent is not a

2.16 (1) sexual intercourse, cunnilingus, fellatio, or anal intercourse; or

2.17 (2) any intrusion however slight into the genital or anal openings:

2.18 (i) of the complainant's body by any part of the actor's body or any object used by the  
2.19 actor for this purpose;

2.20 (ii) of the complainant's body by any part of the body of the complainant, by any part  
2.21 of the body of another person, or by any object used by the complainant or another person
