<u>HF4463</u> (Tabke) Individual income and corporate franchise tax provisions modified, and Minnesota housing tax credit modified.

<u>HF4449</u> (Youakim) Sales and use tax exemption removed for detachable units separately sold for landscaping equipment, land clearing services removed from definition of sale and purchase, and exemption modified for materials consumed in agricultural production.
