Bill Description

This bill requires the Department of Labor and Industry (DLI) to develop and make available an educational poster regarding employees' rights under the Employer-Sponsored Meetings or Communication law (Minn. Stat. 181.531) that employers are required to post in the workplace. The poster must be in English, and the five most common languages spoken in Minnesota.

Assumptions

DLI regularly develops and makes available educational posters in multiple languages regarding workplace rights and responsibilities. DLI's Labor Standards Division would develop this poster and coordinate translation and posting on DLI's website with DLI's Communications department.

DLI assumes that the bill language "English and the five most common languages spoken in Minnesota" means English plus the five most common languages spoken in Minnesota other than English and would translate the poster into five total languages. Translation costs and staff time to create the educational posters would be considered other duties as assigned and would have zero impact financially.
