

1.1 moves to amend S.F. No. 2673, in conference committee, as follows:

1.2 On R9-A2, House language, (UES2673-1)

1.3 Page 28, before line 3, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 244.09, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.5 Subd. 3. **Appointment terms.** (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), each appointed
1.6 member shall be appointed for four years and shall continue to serve during that time as
1.7 long as the member occupies the position which made the member eligible for the
1.8 appointment. Each member shall continue in office until a successor is duly appointed.
1.9 Members shall be eligible for reappointment, and appointment may be made to fill an
1.10 unexpired term. The term of any member appointed or reappointed by the governor before
1.11 the first Monday in January 1991 expires on that date. The term of any member appointed
1.12 or reappointed by the governor after the first Monday in January 1991 and before the first
1.13 Monday in January 2023 is coterminous with the governor.

1.14 (b) Members other than the chief justice, commissioner of corrections, or their designees
1.15 appointed after the first Monday in 2023 shall be appointed to staggered terms of four years.
1.16 The terms of initial board members appointed after the first Monday in 2023 shall be
1.17 determined by lot as follows: three members must be appointed for a term of two years,
1.18 three members must be appointed for a term of three years, and three members must be
1.19 appointed for a term of four years. Members of the board serve until the expiration of the
1.20 term to which they have been appointed or until their successors are duly appointed. Members
1.21 shall be eligible for reappointment, and appointment may be made to fill an unexpired term.

1.22 (c) The members of the commission shall elect any additional officers necessary for the
1.23 efficient discharge of their duties."
