Summary

Under current law, when a state agency is required to submit a report to the legislature, the agency is required to file two hard copies with the Legislative Reference Library, as well as making the report available to the library electronically. This bill amends that requirement so that an agency is only required to submit one hard copy of the report, along with an electronic copy.
