

Dakota County 2022 North Creek Greenway Crossings



VI-2022

The North Creek Greenway's 14-mile route will travel through the communities of Eagan, Apple Valley, Lakeville, Farmington and Empire Township. The greenway will connect important regional destinations, including Lebanon Hills Regional Park, the Minnesota Zoo, downtown Farmington, numerous schools, retail centers, local parks, the Vermillion River and multiple state wildlife management areas.

The issue: Funding is needed to provide safe, grade-separated crossings at multiple high-traffic roads and highways and to fill key gaps in the greenway.

The solution: Enhance highway safety improvements for pedestrians and bicyclists by providing a grade-separated crossing of County Road 42 and a connection to 147th Street.

State request: \$5.4 million

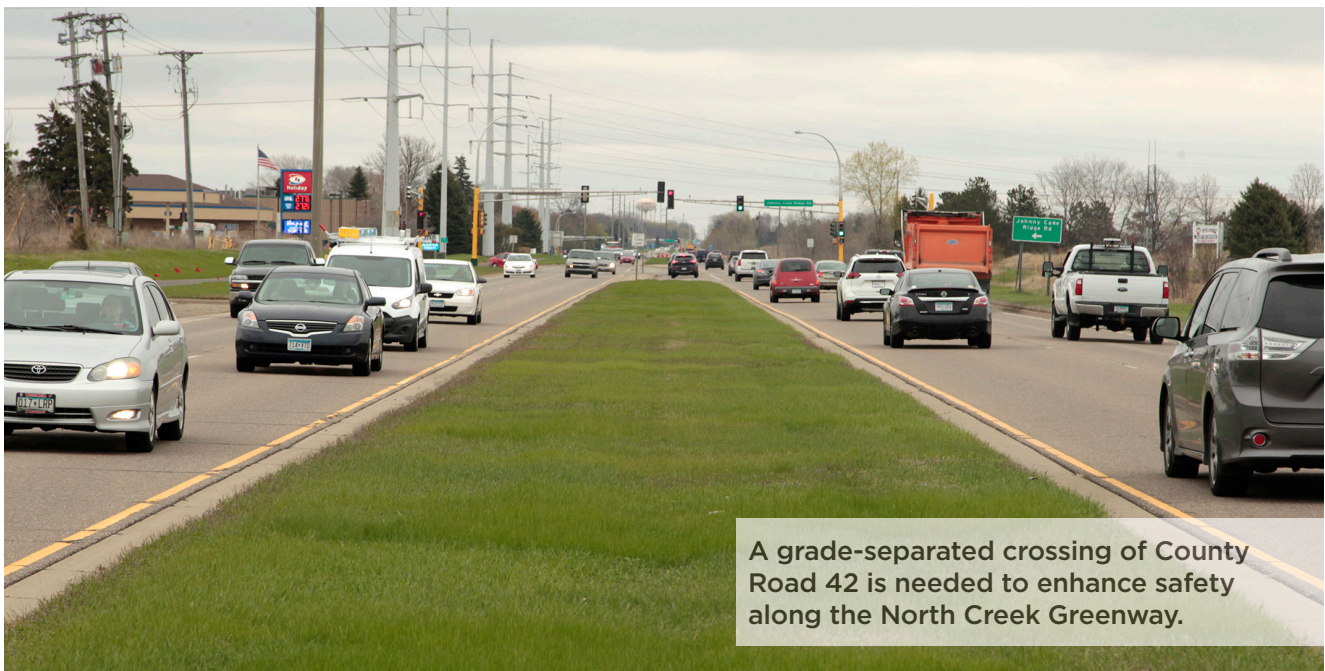
