Subject Youth peer recovery support services pilot project

Summary

This bill appropriates an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2025 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a grant to Hennepin County to conduct a two-year pilot project to provide peer recovery support services to youth between 13 and 18 years of age. Specifies the pilot project must be conducted in partnership with a community organization that provides culturally specific peer recovery support services to East African individuals and that is working to expand peer recovery support services for youth in Hennepin County. Requires Hennepin County to submit a report to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services detailing implementation, operation, and outcomes of the pilot project and providing recommendations to expand youth peer recovery support services statewide. Makes the base appropriation for this purpose an unspecified amount in fiscal year 2026 and \$0 in fiscal year 2027.
