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Our Mission


Improve and protect Minnesota's water and soil resources by working in partnership with local organizations and private landowners.


\$20k-\$40K Grants to build corridors for at-risk species in partnership with local communities





Project Outcomes & Next Steps

- Nearly 4000 funded projects have been completed since 2019, over 5 million square feet
- Will award additional 2000+ individual support grants in spring and later summer cohorts through new funding
- Recruit and train additional coaches
