1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. CITY OF WOODBURY; USE OF LOCAL LODGING TAX.
1.6	Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 469.190, subdivision 3, or any other
1.7	provision of law, ordinance, or city charter, the city of Woodbury may dedicate up to
1.8	two-thirds of the revenue derived from the lodging tax imposed under Minnesota Statutes,
1.9	section 469.190, subdivision 1, for capital improvements to public recreational facilities.
1.10	The city must use the remaining proceeds derived from the tax as required under Minnesota
1.11	Statutes, section 469.190, subdivision 3.
1.12	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day after the governing body of the
1.13	city of Woodbury and its chief clerical officer comply with Minnesota Statutes, section
1.14	645.021, subdivisions 2 and 3.
