1.1 Lesch from the Judiciary Finance and Civil Law Division to which was referred:

1.2 H. F. No. 1731, A bill for an act relating to veterinary medicine; establishing a veterinary
1.3 prescription monitoring program; prohibiting veterinary prescriptions for controlled
1.4 substances in certain circumstances; requiring registration and data submission; providing
1.5 liability immunity; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, sections
1.6 156.16, by adding subdivisions; 156.18, subdivision 1; proposing coding for new law in
1.7 Minnesota Statutes, chapter 156.

1.8 Reported the same back with the following amendments:

1.9 Page 4, line 5, after the period, insert "The notice must comply with the requirements
1.10 of section 13.04, subdivision 2. The board must develop a model notice for use by prescribing
1.11 veterinarians."

1.12 Page 4, line 7, before "database" insert "password-protected"

1.13 Page 5, lines 11 and 16, delete "subdivision 6, applies" and insert "subdivisions 6 and
1.14 11, apply"

1.15 Page 5, line 22, after "data" insert ", including section 156.082,"

1.16 Page 5, delete subdivision 8

1.17 Page 6, line 5, delete "9" and insert "8"

1.18 Amend the title as follows:

1.19 Page 1, lines 4 to 5, delete "providing liability immunity;"

1.20 With the recommendation that when so amended the bill be returned to the Committee
1.21 on Ways and Means.
