
Mankato Regional Water Resource Recovery Facility HF 145

March 8, 2023



- Facility provides services to 10 jurisdictions, serves approximately 70,000 people and treats 7 million gallons of sewage a day.
- Engineers have put the facility in a rating of critical failure is certain – timing unknown.
- The facility was built in the 1950s and we can no longer find parts for the facility
 - Staff are working with local fabricators to manufacture temporary parts.
 - Delivery of available parts are 25-27 months out facility doesn't have this much time to wait.
- Project allows the addition of the City of Lake Crystal.
 - Lake Crystal has a critical situation with their Treatment Plant – and no plan for it, but to join Mankato.
 - Without our project, we cannot add Lake Crystal to the Mankato Regional Water Resource Recovery Facility – we don't have the capacity.

Current Situation

Current Request – HF 145

- Project cost has escalated to \$89 Million
 Asking for \$44.5 Million
 We have \$44.5 Million in funding secured.
- Project is ready to be sent to out for bid.
