Overview

This bill makes changes in the state's controlled substances schedules, to reflect recent revisions to the federal schedules.

Summary

Section Description

1-4 Changes to controlled substances schedule.

Amend § 152.02, subds. 2, 3, 5, and 6. These sections add substances to the state's controlled substances schedules 1, 2, 4, and 5, to reflect U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration changes to the federal schedules. The amendments in these sections make permanent the changes made in the Board of Pharmacy's scheduling order of March 16, 2022. The changes in the scheduling order are effective for 12 months and cannot be renewed. The effective date of the sections is the day following final enactment.
