Overview

This bill requires that cybersecurity incidents affecting certain public institutions be reported to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, beginning December 1, 2024.

Summary

Section Description

1 Cybersecurity incidents.

Requires that any cybersecurity incident impacting a state agency; a political subdivision; a school district, charter school, intermediate district, cooperative units and public postsecondary institution be reported to the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, in coordination with the Department of Information Technology Services. A number of details related to how a report must be made, and how information related to the report must be handled, are included.

An annual report to the legislature, beginning January 31, 2026, related to these reports is required.
