

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 4289, the delete everything amendment  
1.2 (A18-0800), as follows:

1.3 Page 8, after line 4, insert:

1.4 "(c) \$380,000 in fiscal year 2019 is for grants  
1.5 to organizations to provide lead risk  
1.6 assessments by a lead inspector or a lead risk  
1.7 assessor licensed by the commissioner  
1.8 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section  
1.9 144.9505 to test residential units for the  
1.10 presence of lead hazards. Grant programs  
1.11 receiving funding under this section must  
1.12 provide funding for lead risk assessments for  
1.13 properties built before 1978 to:

1.14 (1) landlords of residential buildings for  
1.15 testing on units where the tenant's income does  
1.16 not exceed 60 percent of area median income;  
1.17 or

1.18 (2) tenants with an income that does not  
1.19 exceed 60 percent of area median income.

1.20 The commissioner shall award grant funding  
1.21 to target grant resources to landlords and  
1.22 tenants where there are high concentrations  
1.23 of lead poisoning in children based on the  
1.24 information provided from the commissioner  
1.25 of health. Up to ten percent of the grant may  
1.26 be used to administer the grant and provide

- 2.1 education and outreach about lead health
- 2.2 hazards. This is a onetime appropriation."
- 2.3 Adjust amounts accordingly
