

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 222, the delete everything amendment  
1.2 (H0222DE7), as follows:

1.3 Page 5, after line 16, insert:

1.4 "(d) Direct access from the internet to any system component in an automated license  
1.5 plate reader data environment is prohibited. In addition to the requirements of subdivision  
1.6 7, before allowing user access to any system component in an automated license plate  
1.7 reader data environment, the user must be assigned a unique username and password. The  
1.8 use of the same username by more than one person is prohibited. No person, other than  
1.9 the individual assigned the username and password, may know the password.

1.10 (e) Use of a username or password by a user who is not assigned that username is  
1.11 prohibited. Use of a system account or service account to access any data or system  
1.12 component within the automated license plate reader data environment is prohibited. All  
1.13 paper and electronic media containing automated license plate reader data, including paper  
1.14 and electronic backups, must be stored in a physically secure location."
