During the Minnesota Department of Education's presentation on the governor's budget you passed along a question to MDE staff about whether third-party recipients of education funding (like Northside Achievement Zone and Saint Paul Promise Neighborhood) are required to adhere to accessibility requirements that bind government agencies.

After inquiring with the MDE communications department and MN.IT, the answer to your inquiry is that while these recipients are strongly encouraged to comply with state accessibility requirements they are not required to do so.
