1.5 Subd. 2a. Access to welfare system data; audit trail. (a) Only individuals with
1.6 explicit authorization from the responsible authority may enter, update, or access not
1.7 public data that is collected, maintained, or used by the welfare system. The ability of
1.8 authorized individuals to enter, update, or access these data must be limited through the
1.9 use of role-based access that corresponds to the official duties or training level of the
1.10 individual, and the statutory authorization that grants access for that purpose. All queries
1.11 and responses, and all actions in which data are entered, updated, accessed, or shared or
1.12 disseminated, must be recorded in a data audit trail. Data contained in the audit trail are
1.13 public, to the extent that the data are not otherwise classified by law.

1.14 (b) The authorization of any individual determined to have willfully entered,
1.15 updated, accessed, shared, or disseminated data in violation of this section, or any other
1.16 provision of law, must be immediately and permanently revoked. If an individual is
1.17 determined to have willfully gained access to data without explicit authorization, the
1.18 responsible authority must forward the matter to the county attorney for prosecution."
