1.5 "(a) An applicant qualifies as a social equity applicant if the applicant:

1.6 (1) was convicted of an offense involving the possession or sale of cannabis or marijuana
1.7 prior to May 1, 2023;

1.8 (2) had a parent, guardian, child, spouse, or dependent who was convicted of an offense
1.9 involving the possession or sale of cannabis or marijuana prior May 1, 2023;

1.10 (3) was a dependent of an individual who was convicted of an offense involving the
1.11 possession or sale of cannabis or marijuana prior to May 1, 2023;

1.12 (4) is a service-disabled veteran, current or former member of the national guard, or any
1.13 military veteran or current or former member of the national guard who lost honorable status
1.14 due to an offense involving the possession or sale of marijuana;

1.15 (5) has been a resident for the last five years of one or more subareas, such as census
1.16 tracts or neighborhoods, that experienced a disproportionately large amount of cannabis
1.17 enforcement as determined by the study conducted by the office pursuant to section 342.04,
1.18 paragraph (b), and reported in the preliminary report, final report, or both;

1.19 (6) is an emerging farmer as defined in section 17.055, subdivision 1; or"
