Thank you for considering my re-appointment to the Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board. I was appointed and confirmed to the "Former DFL Legislator" position.

While in the Senate I was DFL majority whip, chaired several committees including Ethics and Transportation. I also served on Taxes and Rules. Previous employment included Associate Director of Council 6 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME), Minnesota Department of Employee Relations work on pay equity and 15 years in various civil service positions at the University of Minnesota. Along the way I serviced on the Metropolitan Waste Control Commission and the Metropolitan Council.

My service on the Board has included continued work to assist candidates, campaigns and the public in complying with the law through improved training and internet access. Despite the evenly divided political make-up of the Board most actions are agreed to by consensus and even where there is disagreement, we seldom divide along party lines.
