





Change in firearm fatalities in children and adolescents by intent 2012-2021


83% INCREASE in unintentional deaths70% INCREASE in suicide deaths85% INCREASE in violence-related deaths





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Change in fatalities in children and adolescents by cause 2001-2021





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- Case fatality rates from pediatric firearm injuries are high
- In contrast to most other trends in pediatric fatalities, pediatric firearm fatalities have increased dramatically in the last 1-2 decades
