

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; allowing strong beer licenses for certain town ball game events;
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.403, subdivision 1.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Issuance by county or city.** The governing body of a city or county may
1.7 issue off-sale or on-sale licenses for the sale of 3.2 percent malt liquor within their respective
1.8 jurisdictions. If the governing body elects, an on-sale 3.2 percent malt liquor license may
1.9 also authorize the sale of intoxicating malt liquor to persons attending town ball games. For
1.10 purposes of this subdivision, "town ball games" means baseball games conducted through
1.11 a league established by the Minnesota Baseball Association or similar events. Any license
1.12 issued under this subdivision shall be considered a 3.2 percent malt liquor license for purposes
1.13 of this chapter.
