Crime trends have shifted and increased over last decade


- Testing of sexual assault kits now required by law
- Digital evidence unheard of 10 years ago
- Methamphetamine and opioid abuse rampant in communities
- Internet crimes have added to child abuse and human trafficking cases


Forensic evidence testing increasing exponentially

- Evidence submissions for DNA analysis have increased 200% in last decade
- Controlled substance submissions have nearly doubled over the last five years
- Digital media evidence analysis increased by 122% between 2017 and 2021

Additional facility to meet the needs of criminal justice partners


- Provide investigative, laboratory and training services at regional level in Southern Minnesota
- Eliminate local agency time and resources to transport items to BCA Headquarters in St. Paul
- Reduce turnaround time for evidence testing

Operational needs for additional facility

- St. Paul Headquarters over capacity by ~150 staff plan to relocate >20 staff
- Highly technical services with unique instrumentation, equipment, storage and security requirements









Special Agents tripled in just one office & overcrowding







Southern Minnesota BCA Regional Office and Laboratory



\$47.998 Million – Southern Minnesota Regional Office Construction

- Approximately 44,000 square feet
- Initial staffing 27 FTEs (relocating ~21 from St. Paul)
- Planning for current and future needs with capacity for approximately 50 FTEs
- Significant investment of state resources already made in this project

Work completed

- Pre-Design funding received in 2020
- Pre-Design completed in 2021
- Design funding received in 2023 (\$4.5 million)
- Dept. of Administration has purchased needed land in Mankato

Forensic evidence testing increasing exponentially

- Case submissions to Bemidji facility have increased more than 150% since 2004
- Demands for forensic testing continue to increase annually
- Projected to increase at comparable rates over next 20 years
- Need to decrease turnaround time for evidence testing





Significant increase in volume and complexity of investigative services also drive space needs

- Independent space for Force Investigations Unit
- New digital evidence laboratory
- Other space needs for specialized investigation functions
 - Polygraph room
 - Additional secure evidence storage
 - Audio/Video enhancements and 3D scanner analysis
- Expanded training space for regional training



Specialized space needed for this work






Bemidji Regional Office and Laboratory Expansion



\$4.061 Million- Expansion of Bemidji Regional Office - Land and Design Cost

- Built in 2001 need to plan for current and future needs
- Double current space to 53,000 square feet (27,000 sq. ft. new and 26,000 sq. ft. renovated)
- Original staff capacity for 36, current staff 40 with additional growth expected
- Pre-Design completed in 2021









Minnesota State Patrol Headquarters Design

\$22.456M - Minnesota State Patrol Headquarters Design and Land Acquisition (part of \$113.6M pre-design report)

- 137,000 total square feet (97,000 office + 40,000 garage).
- Combines 6 separate leased spaces into one comprehensive facility.
 - Synergy with leadership + command + teams = efficiency.
 - Access to the public with ample and free parking.
 - Adequate training space to fulfill needs into the future.
 - Recruitment/retention requirements in an ultra competitive environment.
 - Readiness for response to disasters with garage storage for equipment.
 - Advanced physical security concepts vs the current problem.
 - Meets/exceeds many best-practices outlined within the Commission on Law Enforcement Accreditation (CALEA) standards.
