Representatives all,

Enclosed is one citizen's anti-gerrymandering, party impacts ignored, MN Congressional Redistricting proposal, for which I ask your consideration.

My guiding principles in proceeding with this project have been (in this order):

- 1. Hold county lines harmless to the largest extent possible;
- 2. Where priority # 1 is not possible, hold municipal lines harmless;
- 3. Avoid grotesque shapes, such as our existing Congressional District 6;
- 4. Avoid monstrous sprawls, such as our existing Congressional District 7;
- 5. Combine rapid growth areas with slow growth and/or no-growth areas.

It is my recollection that in the past, panels with your responsibility have sometimes adhered to precise Census population equality among the newly-drawn Congressional Districts, as an absolute necessity.

This time, I ask you to prevail upon your colleagues for relief from that stringent requirement, in acknowledgment of the following self-evident realities:

- 1. The Census, being a human enterprise, never actually achieves perfection;
- 2. Births, deaths and mobility inevitably skew reality before any official count is announced;
- 3. Given the Covid Nightmare Effect(s), our 2020 count was likely less accurate than usual.

Additionally, please note that each of the Congressional District numbers in my enclosed proposal deviates LESS THAN 1% from the 713,312 ideal.


