#### Reconstruction of Nicollet is overdue.

- Built in 1961, the failing infrastructure is the driving need for the project.
- The underground utilities were constructed in the late 1950s.

## Nicollet is the most dangerous county road in Richfield (per mile).

- Over 850 local residents cross this regional corridor on foot or bicycle everyday.
- While Nicollet makes up only 1.5% of local roadway miles in Richfield it is the location of 12% of the crashes (226 crashes) in the city (2018-2023).
- Compared city-wide, the following stats occurred in the project area (2018-2023)
  - 16% of serious injury crashes
  - 33% of fatal crashes
  - 5% of car-on-pedestrian crashes in Richfield occur in the project area (2018-2023).
- Recently collected U of M data found only 5% of vehicles yielded to pedestrians at 73rd Street
  on Nicollet.

Richfield needs \$10M to secure this project.





### Nicollet is a regional economic corridor.

- Key multimodal regional connection between Bloomington and Downtown Minneapolis.
- Metro Transit's Route 18 is the highest frequency bus line between Bloomington and Downtown
- 11,000 vehicles per day.
- More than 50% of all traffic is pass-through (regional), while local use accounts for 10%
- Regional destinations Academy of Holy Angels, Hennepin County Library, Inclusive Playground

Richfield needs \$10M to secure this project.



### Why bonding?

- Richfield has limited local capacity to financially support this project.
- Total Cost \$25,700,000 est.
  - Local Cost Share \$15,700,000 (Hennepin County)
  - \$10,000,000 identified for Richfield
- Since 2003, <u>Richfield has financed over \$42,000,000 toward regional projects</u> through bonding and Municipal State Aid (MSA).
- The City's resources are tapped out and we need your help.

Everyday this corridor has

551 pedestrian crossings - 327 Bicycle crossings - 193 bus boardings and our community deserves to feel safe.

We can do better but we need your help.
