## Summary

This bill would prohibit a person from planting corn on lands administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for commercial purposes beginning January 1, 2026. The bill provides an exemption from the prohibition for those who have entered into an agreement with the DNR prior to January 1, 2025. Beginning January 1, 2025, the DNR would be prohibited from entering into agreements allowing commercial corn production.

Requires the DNR to transition existing corn plots to native vegetation and states that the DNR may use money statutorily appropriated to it for other purposes as necessary to convert the corn plots.
