I <u>strongly oppose</u> the language Omnibus Bill in the House Education Policy Committee about the test reporting requirements change in language. Specifically, I am concerned with the additional requirement of "proof of prior testing plan" and a "copy of the official test scores." I am not clear why this new requirement is being reintroduced at this time. There is *no credible evidence* to suggest that a change in homeschool standardized testing reporting requirements is necessary or useful. This reporting requirement is contrary to the 2011 Homeschool Mandate Reduction bill. At that time, the school districts also concluded that they did not want to receive and maintain unnecessary paperwork from homeschoolers - nor do homeschoolers need or want the additional paperwork.
