RE: House File 1477, Funding for the AGRI Bioincentive Program

Dear Chair Vang, Representative Tabke, and Committee Members,

On behalf of Clean Energy Economy MN (CEEM), I write today in support of HF1477, which would bring additional funding to Minnesota's successful Bioincentive Program. This funding is critical to the partnership between Minnesota and private sector companies investing in the state's economy. Increased state investment in this program will attract more private sector investment and spur greater economic activity for local communities.

CEEM is an industry-led, nonpartisan, non-profit organization representing the business voice of energy efficiency and clean energy in Minnesota. The incentives help private sector companies and facilities to increase the utilization of local biomass resources, spur economic growth, and supply good-paying jobs across Greater Minnesota.
