

SF3035 Conference Committee Members MN State Capitol May 2023

RE: Support & Pass SF3035, Article 13 (Building & Construction Contracts)

Honorable Conference Committee Members,

The MN Subcontractors Association (MSA) asks that you support & pass SF3035, Article 13 (Building & Construction Contracts) aka the "Duty to Defend" bill.

Article 13 is about fairness. It ensures that a negligent party pays for their own legal costs. The bill has bipartisan support in the legislature & the support from a broad cross-section of organizations including labor, management, trail attorneys & the MN Council on Latino Affairs.

When a general contractor is negligent, the general contractor should take responsibility, and when a subcontractor is negligent the subcontractor should take responsibility. **Minnesota's laws** should reflect principles of basic fairness and remove barriers for small businesses.

The current defense demands in MN construction contracts are fundamentally unfair, often non-negotiable & they hurt small businesses. Harm occurs when subcontractors must choose between agreeing to sign these unfair terms or giving up the work. Harm occurs again when a claim arises & when the unfair duty to defend contract terms are used to negotiate an unfair settlement.

The 2017 MN Joint Disparity Study recommends to "Jointly pursue action by the State Legislature to reduce barriers to public sector procurement embedded in state law." MSA agrees, and we need the legislature to end unfair "duty to defend" contract terms to ensure an equitable allocation of risk.

Please support & pass SF3035, Article 13 (Building & Construction Contracts).
