Subject Mammogram Diagnostic Services and Testing

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#### **Overview**

This bill requires health plans, medical assistance, and MinnesotaCare to cover additional diagnostic services or testing after a mammogram if a health care provider believes it is necessary.

## **Summary**

#### **Section Description**

#### 1 Mammogram; diagnostic services and testing.

Provides that if an enrollee requires additional diagnostic services or testing after a mammogram, a health plan must provide coverage for these services and testing with no-cost sharing, including co-payments, coinsurance, or deductibles.

**Effective date.** This section is effective January 1, 2024.

### 2 Application.

Clarifies that section 1 applies after an enrollee has met their deductible if section 1 would make the enrollee's health savings account or catastrophic health plan ineligible for tax benefits.

**Effective date.** This section is effective January 1, 2024.

### 3 Exceptions.

Prohibits the application of co-payments, coinsurance, and deductibles for mammogram diagnostic services and testing for medical assistance enrollees.

**Effective date.** This section is effective January 1, 2024.

#### 4 Cost-sharing.

Prohibits the application of co-payments, coinsurance, and deductibles for mammogram diagnostic services and testing for MinnesotaCare enrollees.
