I live in Minneapolis and my 2-year-old son Henry attends Circulo de Amigos daycare in East Phillips, right across the street from Smith Foundry. He loves his school so much, and the teachers and staff there are incredible and have created an environment where kids can truly grow and thrive--including lots of time outdoors. However, because facilities like Smith Foundry and Bituminous Roadways are allowed to remain in residential neighborhoods, the school has to deal with air pollution, bad smells, and concerns about the safety of letting kids play.
