Overview

This bill modifies the qualification requirements for licensure as an assisted living director and requires assisted living directors to obtain continuing education to maintain their licenses.

Summary

Section Description

1 Assisted living director qualifications; ongoing training.

Amends § 144A.20, subd. 4. Requires an individual applying for a license as an assisted living director to apply within 30 days of hire rather than six months as in current law, and to meet the standards for licensure within 30 days of hire rather than one year as in current law. Modifies qualifications for licensure by specifying a nursing home administrator seeking an assisted living director license must be licensed as a nursing home administrator in Minnesota. Strikes obsolete language. Requires an assisted living director to receive at least 30 hours of continuing education, rather than training, every two years.
