## **Summary**

This bill establishes a Legislative Task Force on Aging. The task force is charged with reviewing state demographics and a number of other issues affecting healthy aging in the community, with a goal of examining whether the creation of a state Department on Aging is necessary. The specific areas of focus for the potential new department are listed in subdivision 1, and the scope of duties for this task force are listed in subdivision 2.

The task force consists of eight members, including two members from each legislative chamber.

The task force is required to submit a report to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services finance and policy no later than May 30, 2026.
