

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 2875 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, after line 10, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 2. Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 4, article 2, section 3, is amended by
1.4 adding a subdivision to read:

1.5 Subd. 7. **Prairie Island Net Zero Project.** (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes,
1.6 section 116C.779, subdivision 1, paragraph (j), \$15,200,000 in fiscal year 2022 and
1.7 \$15,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 are appropriated from the renewable development account
1.8 under Minnesota Statutes, section 116C.779, subdivision 1, to the commissioner of commerce
1.9 for a grant to the Prairie Island Indian Community to implement the Prairie Island Net Zero
1.10 Project under Laws 2020, chapter 118, section 3. The base for this project in fiscal year
1.11 2024 is \$0. Any unspent funds remaining upon completion of the project cancel to the
1.12 renewable development account under Minnesota Statutes, section 116C.779, subdivision
1.13 1. The commissioner of commerce shall manage the grant, including the disbursement of
1.14 grant funds to the Prairie Island Indian Community.

1.15 (b) The commissioner shall reserve a portion of the appropriation made under this section
1.16 to pay actual expenditures on the project that exceed the certified total cost. The amount
1.17 reserved shall be the lesser of:

1.18 (1) 20 percent of the certified total cost for the project; or

1.19 (2) the difference between the certified total cost and \$46,200,000.

1.20 (c) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), if the certified total cost for the project is less than
1.21 \$46,200,000, the commissioner shall withhold from the project appropriation in fiscal year
1.22 2023 an amount equal to the difference between \$46,200,000 and the sum of the amount
1.23 of the certified total cost and the amount reserved by the commissioner under paragraph
1.24 (b), and shall cancel the withheld amount to the renewable development account.

2.1 (d) For the purposes of this subdivision, "certified total cost" means the total cost of all
2.2 contracts the Prairie Island Indian Community enters into with contractors to complete the
2.3 Prairie Island Net Zero Project under Laws 2020, chapter 118, section 3."
