1.14	EFFECTIVE DATE. (a) This section is effective the day following final enactment

1.17	(b) This section expires four calendar months after Emergency Executive Order No.
1.18	20-18 or a related emergency executive order extending the closure of bars, restaurants, and
1.19	other places of public accommodation, is terminated or rescinded, or has expired, and the
