In addition to the written essay, the application should include **one** letter of recommendation from a teacher or academic advisor.

GUIDELINES AND PROVISIONS

Please carefully review the following information.

- Program participants are expected to participate in all scheduled events and activities; accommodations in the schedule will not be made for extra curricular activities or other prior commitments.
- Participants are not permitted to leave any of the program’s activities without the explicit authorization of the program advisor.
- Participants are under direct supervision only during sponsored program activities and events; students are not supervised after the conclusion of the normal working day.
- **Program participants are expected to adhere to a professional dress code. Students that do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to participate in program activities.**
- Program participants are responsible for all personal costs associated with their participation in the program. Students will receive a small stipend designed to cover a portion of their meals and, if applicable, cover the cost of lodging.
- **If the Legislature adjourns prior to the completion of the program, the remainder of the High School Page Program will be cancelled and affected students will be notified accordingly.**
