Repeals the following provisions of Minnesota Statutes:

169.01, subdivision 18, defining "trackless trolley" as a vehicle that draws power from overhead wires but does not run on rails. Also deletes references to trackless trolleys in other traffic law provisions.

169.38, requiring drivers to honk their horns within 200 feet of a curve when the driving in "defiles or canyons or on mountain highways."

169.901, prohibiting hiring a person "addicted to the excessive use of intoxicating liquors" to drive a passenger vehicle.
