- 1 **Access to respite care.** Amends § 256B.501, by adding subd. 4c. Requires a county agency, upon request of a person receiving services under the community-based waiver for persons with mental retardation and related conditions, or the recipient's legal representative, to screen the recipient and place the recipient on and off the waiver as needed in order to allow the recipient access to short-term care in an ICF/MR.
