- 1 **Racetrack employee licenses.** Amends the law that prohibits issuance of a class C (occupational) license by the racing commission to a person who has ever been convicted of a felony, by making it apply only to felony convictions of record.
- 2 **Medication.** Increases from 3 to 5 micrograms per milliliter of blood the maximum content of anti-inflammatory drugs (such as phenylbutazone) in a test sample that must be permitted under the medication rules of the racing commission.
- 3 **Effective date.** Makes sections 1 and 2 effective immediately.
