- 1 **Fire training ash disposal.** Specifies that the ash from a fire training exercise must be classified as demolition debris and may be disposed of in any "permit by rule" land disposal facility or any permitted demolition landfill, with the consent of the land fill operator, if:
- (1) the fire training exercise is a legitimate training event; and
 - (2) a person trained at a MNSCU fire safety center certifies in writing that the structure:
 - has been adequately prepared for the training exercise; and
 - satisfies all applicable concerns and regulations, including pollution control agency guidelines regarding the removal of hazardous materials from the structure.
- Minnesota Rules, part 7001.3050, subpart 3, specifies that the owner or operator of the certain facilities is deemed to have obtained a solid waste management facility permit without making application for it, unless the commissioner finds that the facility is not in compliance with listed requirements.
