### Overview

All employers who intend to hire minors are required to verify the minor's age. Currently, this can only be done using an age certificate (which can be issued by a school superintendent), a birth certificate, or a driver's license. This bill would also allow federal immigration documentation to be used.

### Section

- 1 **Age certification.** Allows the use of a Department of Justice Immigration and Naturalization Service Employment Eligibility Form I-9 as an alternative method of proving a minor's age.
