### Section

- 1 **Credit discrimination.** Amends the credit discrimination provision. Adds receipt of public assistance and housing assistance to the prohibited grounds (see section 5).
- 2 **Formulation of policies.** Amends a current list of duties of the commissioner of human rights. To the current duty to subpoena witnesses and take testimony, adds the phrase "as the commissioner deems appropriate to carry out the purposes of this chapter."
- 3 **Scope of application.** Amends the statute that requires an affirmative action plan from certain state contractors. Makes technical changes.
- 4 **Rules for certificates of compliance.** Amends another statute on affirmative action plan requirements from certain state contractors. Makes technical changes.
- 5 **Repealer.** Repeals a definition of "hearing examiner" because that term is no longer used. Repeals a provision prohibiting denial of credit service on the basis of receiving public assistance or housing assistance (see section 1).
