- 6     **Establishment of compact council.** Establishes a compact council with authority to promulgate rules and procedures governing the use of the federal system for noncriminal justice purposes and provides for the organization, membership, and operation of the council.
- 7     **Ratification of compact.** Specifies that the compact will take effect upon being entered into by two or more states.
- 8     **Miscellaneous provisions.** Specifies the relation of the compact to certain FBI activities and other miscellaneous provisions.
- 9     **Renunciation.** Provides that the compact is binding upon states that become a party until it is renounced by the state under specified circumstances.
- 10    **Severability.** If a portion of the compact is held unconstitutional, provides that the remaining provisions remain in effect.
- 11    **Adjudication of disputes.** Specifies the authority of the council, the duties of the FBI, and the right of appeal when disputes arise under the compact.

Section 3 vests the powers and duties related to the compact with the commissioner of public safety.
