Overview

Under current law, upon approval of the commissioner of children, families, and learning and when economically advantageous, a school district may make a levy to pay for rent on certain leased facilities. The leased facilities must be used for instructional purposes, or for school storage or furniture repair. The leased levy may not be used for the purpose of leasing a newly constructed building for regular kindergarten, elementary, or secondary purposes. A district's lease levy must not exceed \$100 times the district's resident pupil units for that year.

H. F. 2361 grants the Yellow Medicine East school district authority to levy the amounts for lease payments associated with the Kilowatt community center for activity programs, and swimming and water instruction.
