Permits Cook county to convey the land and property of the Mineral Center cemetery to the Grand Portage Reservation if the county and the tribal council agree to the conveyance, notwithstanding certain statutes (below). Effective the day after enactment.

Minnesota Statutes, section 306.243, subdivision 5, permits a county that has assumed maintenance of an abandoned cemetery for a period of at least one year to transfer the cemetery land and property as provided in section 306.02. Section 306.02, permits a local government unit to transfer ownership of a cemetery to an existing cemetery association.
