## Bill Summary

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**Subject:** State auditor

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### Overview

This bill provides for certain local government information to be reported to other agencies that is currently reported to the state auditor.

#### Section

- 1 **Fees; accounting (solid waste management).** Provides for a political subdivision that provides solid waste management to report annually to the office of environmental assistance on the revenue collected, instead of reporting to the state auditor.
- 2 **Reporting requirement (disposition of forfeited property).** Requires that information on forfeiture incidents be reported to Minnesota Planning in place of the state auditor.
- 3 **Repealer.** Repeals the requirement for the state auditor to collect information and report on legal expenditures of local governments.
- 4 **Effective date.** Section 1 is effective August 1, 2003.
